








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ABOUT ANGELA ARDOLINO

Rushing home, I dropped my bag the moment I got in the door and ran outside to my haven in the back yard where I kept all my pets and "patients." Today I needed to hurry to check on my current patient, a Muscovy Duck named PeeWee. I had raised him from birth when his mother decided she didn't want babies anymore. The night before he had been missing, so I searched and searched until I found him, injured, lying on the bank of our canal. When I picked him up, I noticed his right foot had been bitten up badly by a snapping turtle or alligator. So, like I always did when I found a wounded or hurt animal, I cleaned the wound, applied antibiotic and bandaged him up.

As I approached his pen, I was anxious to see how his foot was doing. PeeWee was so excited to see me, and as I unwrapped the bandage, I realized his foot had rotted off and it was just lying in my hand! I was horrified, but PeeWee was completely unfazed and spent the rest of his life happy and carefree—with one peg-leg. I was always amazed at how quickly animals could heal themselves, adapt and move on, with just a little bit of help.

What is neat about this story is that I was about 8 years old when it happened, and now I'm 50—not much has changed, except that my toolbox for naturally helping and healing animals has greatly improved, and I now understand WHY and HOW animals are able to heal themselves naturally. It was with this knowledge that I founded Fire Flake Farm, a rescue farm for farm animals and dogs, where our specialty is caring for sick or geriatric animals.

Although I had so much experience with so many different animals, I didn't get my first dog until 2000, when I adopted her from a family whose schnauzers had "accidentally" mated. Her name was Lucy, and I loved her to pieces. At that time I still lived in Miami, and a brand new, state-of-the-art vet opened literally across the street from my house, so that's where I took

I did everything my conventional veterinarian instructed me to do. I fed Lucy the best (most



expensive) kibble Purina had to offer, I got her vaccinations done every year, I applied the flea/tick and heartworm meds every month, and she was dead seven years later. My baby girl didn't just die, she suffered. And I stopped keeping track of the over \$15K I spent trying to save her. I even got an autopsy to see what happened, and all they found was IBS. This set the course of my life, as I soon discovered that by doing everything I was told, from diet to meds, I had killed her natural ability to heal herself, and my veterinarian had no idea.

Veterinarians, just like most Doctors, are NOT taught about diet and nutrition in school. How is that okay? They are also NOT taught about the Endocannabinoid System, or how cannabis medicine interacts with this system, which is responsible for keeping all our other physiological systems operating correctly. And since most Veterinarians don't know about diet and nutrition, the only thing they have in their treatment arsenal is pharmaceutical drugs.

Because most vets know nothing about diet and nutrition, big corporations like Mars and Smuckers created "Science Diets" or "prescription diets" so that veterinarians could recommend and sell food at their practices. The problem is that these "diets" are NOT based on science at all, and most are non-food made with the worst ingredients possible. I won't go on about how corrupt the pet food industry is right now, that will be in my next book: "How to Not Kill Your Dog or Go Broke Trying to Save It".

Did you know that most veterinarians get out of school facing \$200-300K in debt? And if they want to go out and learn about holistic remedies, diet and nutrition, or eastern medicine, they must enroll in continuing education and pay more money to learn about ancient ways of health and healing that has been proven to work for thousands of years!

The main causes of our pets' diseases and suffering are caused by diet, overmedicating and vaccinations. PERIOD.

Besides Fire Flake Farm, I also own and operate two locations of a grooming, daycare and retail shop called Beautify the Beast. My experience there has enabled me to see that most of our pets are suffering from non-food/kibble diets, over-vaccinations, and over-medicating of toxic pharmaceuticals, just like Lucy did. I couldn't believe that what I went through with Lucy is what most pet parents are going through. This needs to stop, and making it stop has become my

I knew that to best help the animals I care for, and to help others do the same, I'd need to learn about the most effective and promising all-natural health treatments that veterinarians weren't learning about. And having spent several years looking for ways to treat my own rheumatoid arthritis, I knew that one naturally occurring substance might have the answer to many of the pet health issues I was seeing: Cannabis.

So, I spent two years of my life traveling throughout North America, learning from cannabis industry professionals, growers, cultivators—basically anyone who would talk to me. I was invited to attend the inaugural medical cannabis program at The Robert Larner, M.D. College of Medicine at the University of Vermont, and earned a certificate in the therapeutic uses of medical cannabis. I joined Women Grow, United for Care, and Canna Moms, and threw myself into advocating for common-sense cannabis legislation. I created and hosted Canna Conference, a statewide convention which brought together doctors, nurses, veterinarians, health professionals, and the general public to learn about medical cannabis from highly esteemed speakers. And based on the overwhelming response I was seeing, I made it my mission to continue educating as many people as possible about how cannabis can help people and their pets.

While I was learning, the world was

learning too. Medical cannabis legislation was being introduced in states across the country, including my home state of Florida. This new frontier was a free-for-all, including dissemination of misinformation and even flat-out lies by those seeking to profit, so I did everything in my power to educate myself and others with the facts on medical cannabis. That is why I felt so passionate about getting out there and spreading non-biased research and information. It's the same reason why I still work so hard to share the truth today. And it's why you are reading this magazine right

During my early research phase, I was searching but unable to find a product that I felt was safe enough to give to my dogs or that provided any significant health improvement, so I set out to develop one myself. Because, let's be perfectly honest with each other here, the world did not need another sub-par product made by a big pharmaceutical company who doesn't care about animals and only cares about the bottom line. The world needs education on natural health treatments, including CBD and similar products, made by people who care about and love animals. I know deep in my soul that this is what I was born to do.

In 2016 I began searching for ethical hemp farmers who were growing pesticide- and herbicide-free hemp, and I started to assemble my dream team of advisors.

I met a chemist who helped me formulate my first line of products, incorporating other plant essential oils that are synergistic with cannabis like Lavender, Frankincense and Turmeric.

Around this time, I also asked my former student, friend, and Broadway star Hernando Umana if he would like to partner with me on this journey. He was as obsessed with CBD as I was, since cannabis had changed both his life and his dog's life (more on that later), and he was on board from the moment I asked.

If I can teach you just one thing, I hope it is this:



ADAPTOGENS



Plants and Fungi with super powers

WHAT ARE THEY?

Adaptogens are plants and mushrooms that help your body respond to stress, anxiety, fatigue and overall wellbeing. You can take adaptogens by adding them to food or beverages or take them as tinctures. Adaptogens bring your body back to a steady balance by managing both physical and mental stressors.

The goal of taking adaptogens is to return your body back to a state of balance (homeostasis). The herbal action in adaptogens increases or decreases chemical reactions within your body by interacting with the Endocannabinoid System.

For example, if you're stressed (elevated cortisol), an adaptogen will respond by reducing cortisol levels. If you experience chronic fatigue with low cortisol levels, an adaptogen will increase the level of cortisol in your body.

In 1998, the American Food and Drug Administration (FDA) [3] defined an adaptogen as a new kind of metabolic regulator that has been proved to help in environmental adaptation and to prevent external harms. Adaptogen has been generally used as a functional term.

COMBINING THEM

Like Cannabis many adaptogens share some of the same chemical compounds called Terpenes and Flavanoids which exhibit neuroprotective, anti-inflammatory, anticancer, antidepressive, anxiolytic, nootropic and CNS stimulating activity. So when you combine adaptogenic plants, herbs and mushrooms with cannabis, they work synergystically to bring the body back to homeostasis.

The normal paradigm one drug for one disease is not appropriate for adaptogens, as they can have numerous pharmacological effects and indications. Therefore, all these pharmacological effects can be combined into the groups associated with stimulating and stress-protective effects in CNS and immune-neuro-endocrine system and the hypothalamic-pituitary-adrenal axis.

Benefits of Adaptogens

- Improve attention
- Increase endurance in situations caused by fatigue
- Lower stress-induced disorders and impairments in the body
- Balance hormone levels
- Keep cortisol (the stress hormone) levels and other hormone levels in check
- Fight fatigue that results from excessive physical or emotional stress
- Combat the impact that stress has on cognitive function
- Stimulate mental performance that has been impacted by stress
- Normalize body functions
- Boost the immune system
- Fight the symptoms caused by elevated cortisol levels (such as anxiety, depression, fatigue, high blood pressure, insulin resistance, and obesity)
- Increase physical stamina and improve energy levels
- Improve the function of organs, such as the liver and adrenal glands
- Improve the function of body systems, such as the gastrointestinal system

OUR FAVORITES FOR PETS

(besides mushrooms and cannabis)

Amla (Phyllanthus emblica): a natural antioxidant with a rich and high source of vitamin C, while also providing cooling, bowel supporting, liver function supporting and detoxifying, eye supporting, anti-microbial, heart protective, immune supporting, inflammation supporting, and connective tissue supporting

Ashwagandha (Withania Somnifera):

has a positive effect on the endocrine, nervous, immune and cardiovascular systems by regulating metabolism and helping relax by calming how

your dog responds to stress. Ashwagandha offers protection for your cells as an antioxidant and reduces swelling (an antiinflammatory reaction). Great for Adrenal Fatigue, Thyroid function, balances blood sugar levels. improves muscle strength, boosts immune function, improves memory, protects brain, fights cancer.

Astragalus root: stimulates the spleen, liver, lungs, circulatory, and urinary system. It's also used to treat osteoarthritis, asthma, and the nervous system. Reduces stress and aging by protecting the telomeres (structures linked with aging, located at the end of each chromosome).

Asian ginseng (Panax ginseng): contains strong antioxidant components that help your dog's body recover from stress, fatigue, and illness. It also contains anti-inflammatory saponins that help to regulate your dog's blood sugar levels.

Bacopa Monnieri: to protect the brain and improve memory and improve other aspects of cognitive function. Has the ability to activate the Nrf2 response in both dogs and cats making it a protector of cell DNA, mitochondria and other important cellular structures from excessive free radical attack. Contains terpenes Limonene and Pinene.

> **Copaiba:** Research indicates that this essential oil has many properties and pathways similar to those of the NSAIDs we currently use for joint discomfort in conventional veterinary medicine. It contains high levels of B-Caryophyllene, a chemical constituent that research shows helps arthritis.

Frakincense: (Boswellia Serrata): This essential oil has a wide array of health benefits. It's anti-inflammatory, antiseptic and an astringent. The oil is also considered a tonic because it benefits all of the body systems, including the digestive, respiratory and nervous systems. Contains terpenes a-pinene and Limonene.

Holy basil (Ocimum Sanctum): Holy basil is an excellent source of calcium, iron, and potassium, which are essential minerals that help keep the organs and metabolic system functioning properly. Holy basil is an effective treatment for ringworms in dogs. Holy 🌉 basil is also used to calm anxious and stressed canines. Terpenes Eugenol, beta-caryophyllene and transbeta-elemene.

Lavender: Lavender soothes and calms the skin, reduces redness, balances oil production, heals blemishes, and stimulates circulation for improved skin tone. Lavender aids depression, insomnia, mood swings, and stress. It clears your athinking, reduces worry, and balances emotions. Contains Linalool, Linalyl, Ocimene.

Milk Thistle (Silybum marianum):

has been extensively studied around the world, and has been shown to be safe and effective in treating a variety of liver diseases and other conditions. It specifically protects the liver against toxins (including some drugs and heavy metals), activates protein synthesis, and stimulates growth of new liver cells to replace those that are dead or damaged. Milk thistle also has strong antioxidant (destroys oxygen free radicals) and anti-inflammatory actions. Flavanoid - Silymarin.

> Neem (Azadirachta Indica): packs over 140 active compounds that may give it numerous antioxidant and anti-inflammatory effects. It has long served as a treatment for ulcers, gastrointestinal troubles, and brain

Rhodiola Rosea: helps balance mental functions for improved mood, calm yet focused attention, and better sleep. Reduces stress-induced elevations in blood cortisol and helps counter adrenal exhaustion.

Turmeric (Curcumin): has important antioxidant benefits and provides support to the body's natural detoxification and hepatic function. It also supports the health of brain tissue. Curcumin maintains healthy cyclooxygenase (COX)-2 enzyme activity while supporting prostaglandin, leukotriene, and thromboxane metabolism. Helps a variety of conditions including arthritis, digestive disorders, respiratory infections, allergies, liver disease, depression, and many others. It contains a large variety of terpenoids, some of which possess anticancer, antiulcer, and antioxidant properties.

Wild yam (Dioscorea villosa): most famous (for its ability to support women in the health of their reproductive systems. With powerful antispasmodic and anti-inflammatory properties, Wild Yam is often prescribed by herbalists to relieve menstrual cramps, chronic pelvic pain and boosts digestion and improves function of gall bladder and liver.

Medicinal Mushrooms

Nature's pharmacy -----

onsidered vegetables by most people, mushrooms are neither fruits nor vegetables and are more closely related to humans than plants! Mushrooms are a fungus with fruiting bodies that contain in general, on a dry weight basis, about 55% carbohydrate, 32% protein, and 2% fat, and the remaining amount is ash constituting minerals and salts. These fungi have more than 100 medicinal functions* including; antioxidant, anticancer, antidiabetic, antiallergic, immunomodulating, cardiovascular protectant, anticholesterolemic, antiviral, antibacterial, antiparasitic, antifungal, detoxification and hepatoprotective effects. At my rescue farm, Fire Flake Farm, I've used and seen the amazing benefits of these mushrooms; and when combined with other adaptogens like hemp, Ashwagandha, Astragalus Root and Babopa Monnieri there's nothing you

It has also been proven that mushrooms are adept at immune modulation and affect hematopoietic stem cells, lymphocytes, macrophages, T cells, dendritic cells (DCs), and natural killer (NK) cells.1 Extensive research over the last 40 years has demonstrated that mushrooms have potent antineoplastic properties that slow growth of tumors, regulate tumor genes, decrease tumoral angioneogenesis, and increase malignant-cell phagocytosis. This is why I used a mixture of Turkey Tail, Reishi, Shiitake, Maitake, Chaga, Artist Conk, and Red Belted Conk mushrooms for my Doberman Nina, who beat all the odds by living 26 months past her diagnosis of Osteosarcoma.

Mushrooms vary in appearance with more than 14,000 known types, but generally they are distinguished by a stem, fleshy rounded cap, and gills underneath the cap.

HISTORY

Our ancestors have used mushrooms as medicine for thousands of years. The Greek physician Hippocrates, circa 450 BCE, classified the amadou mushroom (Fomes fomentarius) as a potent anti-inflammatory and for cauterizing wounds. The alchemist Tao Hongjing,

from the 5th century, described several medicinal mushrooms, including ling zhi (Ganoderma lucidum) and zhu ling (Dendropolyporus umbellatus), some in use reportedly by Shennong many centuries before. Ötzi, the Ice Man, who lived nearly 5300 years ago, carried amadou and a birch polypore tethered in a pouch

to help him survive in the Alps of northern Italy. First peoples of North America used puffball mushrooms (Calvatia genus) as wound

healers. Although mushrooms have long been used by various cultures, only recently has modern science rediscovered what the ancients knew long ago—that mushrooms can be deep reservoirs of powerful medicines.

MEDICINAL PROPERTIES

The fruiting body is the part you see popped up out of the ground, and it's the "meaty" part of the mushroom we cook and eat. This is what you buy at the grocery store, the fruiting body. The fruiting body is made of condensed mycelium — it's the reproductive structure of the mycelium. The fruiting body of the mushroom contains medicinal compounds called beta-glucans, which are naturally occurring polysaccharides. These are the compounds known for being able to modulate the immune system, and they are responsible for many of the healing properties of the mushrooms.

According to Professor Solomon P. Wasser, researcher at the University of Haifa and editor in chief of the International Journal of Medicinal Mushrooms, there are at least 650 species of mushrooms that are considered medicinal.

Polysaccharides

Polysaccharides are the best known metabolite present in mushrooms, and are known to provide antitumor and immunomodulating properties. D-glucose polysaccharides (glucans) are a type of polysaccharide found in mushrooms that give them some of their medicinal properties.

fungal

Immune responses Polysaccharides:

- The activation of immune cells
- Increased antibody production
- Increased interferon production
- Increased immune activity against a range of cancers
- Inhibition of tumor metastasis
- Reduction in pro-inflammatory cytokines
- Inhibition of prostaglandin synthesis
- Increased Lymphocyte Activating Factor (IL-1)
- Increased Tumor Necrosis Factor production
- Macrophage and Neutrophil Activation
- Cytotoxic T-cell activation

Alpha-glucans

Alpha glucan (starch) is the most common polysaccharide that is widely known and used by us in everyday life as part of many staple foods such as: rice, potatoes, grains, and corn. Medicinal mushrooms in nature and in correct growing conditions contain a very small amounts of starch, less than 4% on average of the dry weight of the mushroom fruiting bodies.

Beta-glucans

Beta-glucans are polysaccharides that occur naturally in the cell walls of functional mushrooms, as well as in oats, barley, bacteria, yeast, and



algae. They are a soluble fiber that carries powerful benefits and are potent immunomodulators, with effects on both innate and adaptive immunity. Beta-glucans act on a diversity of immune related receptors, in particular dectin-1 and CR3, and can trigger a wide spectrum of immune responses.

Dectin-1, which is a type II transmembrane protein receptor that binds (1-3) -beta glucans and (1-6)-beta-glucans, can initiate and regulate the innate immune response. It triggers effective immune responses including phagocytosis and proinflammatory factors production, leading to the elimination of infectious agents.*

Terpenoids

Although polysaccharides—and beta-glucans specifically are the most important ingredient to look for in mushroom supplements, they are certainly not the only ones. After polysaccharides, the second-most important active ingredients in medicinal mushrooms are terpenoids.

Not to be confused with their parent compound terpenes, terpenoids are natural compounds produced by many different organisms, including mushrooms. In particular, diterpenoids, triterpenoids, and sesquiterpenoids are known to have medicinal properties. In fact, terpenoids seem to share many of the same medicinal benefits as beta-glucans, such as boosting immune system function. Terpenoids are known to show anti-infectious and anti-inflammatory activities.

One important thing to keep in mind with terpenoids is that they are not water-soluble. For this reason, they must be extracted from the chosen mushroom through alcohol extraction. Alcohol extraction is typically done as an additional step after hot water extraction, which is why it is called a dual extract, and is necessary for mushrooms like Reishi and Chaga.

Vitamins & Minerals

- B vitamins (B2, B3, folate, B5)

EXTRACTING THE MEDICINE

The fruiting body of mushrooms contains some compounds that can be extracted with hot water (beta-glucans and enzymes) and some that need to be extracted in alcohol (triterpenes) like Reishi. Mushroom extracts should go through a double-triple hot water extraction process (plus alcohol for Reishi) in order to extract all of the beneficial compounds.

Extracts should not include the substrate they are grown on or the mycelium.

HOW IT HELPS OUR PETS

I use mushrooms most when dealing with cancer and old age, and the degenerative diseases that come with it.

Years of research from all over the world prove whole-mushroom extracts from the fruiting bodies contain compounds that modulate tumorigenesis and carcinogenesis at different stages. Because they have many different mechanisms and modes of action on cancer cells and the immune system, medicinal mushrooms could potentially provide additive or even synergistic effects in the prevention and treatment of cancer.

TURKEY TAIL (TRAMETES VERSICOLOR)

The best-researched medicinal mushroom, with several controlled clinical trials demonstrating its increased long-term survivability in patients with gastrointestinal cancers, and to a lesser degree other cancers, with oral application of concentrated extracts of the fruit bodies and mycelium, particularly PSK and PSP. There's a wide range of immunological effects in vitro and in vivo, particularly reticuloendothelial system activation, cytokine modulation (IFN-γ production, IL-2 production), enhancement of dendritic cell viability, T-cell maturation, natural killer cell activity, antibody production, and anti-tumor and anticancer effects. 

CHAGA (INONOTUS OBLIQUUS)

CANNABIS FOR PETS

annabis preparations have historically been used for home remedies, as medicine, as a functional food, and as a source of nutrition, primarily for humans. However, there have been reports of cannabis products being used in animals dating back to the 1800s, when cannabis had become a popular herbal remedy at a time prior to the development of the pharmaceutical industry. Patent medicines containing cannabis, usually in a tincture, were sold to horse owners for colic and other equine ailments, and topical liniments were used externally for joint and lameness problems.

As cannabis became vilified and stigmatized in the 1930s, and as pharmaceutical medicines became more available as substitutes for cannabis products, the use of cannabis for work horses became less common, to nonexistent. For our companion animal species (dogs, cats) the use of cannabis products did not gain popularity until the state-by-state legalization of cannabis for medicinal purposes began in the mid-1990s.

Pet owners, learning of the many benefits that cannabis has created for people, naturally began to explore its use in their pets for the medical problems that were not easily solved by veterinary medicine.

These are problems such as epilepsy that are resistant to pharmaceutical remediation; pain that is poorly responsive to opiates, steroids, and nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs; cancer treatment side effects such as nausea and vomiting; and to treat cancer. Some veterinary patients respond well

to NSAIDs for osteoarthritis, but the drugs themselves can cause toxicity in sensitive patients. The use of cannabis as an alternative means of remediating the pain of arthritis can substitute for these drugs or allow for lower and safer dosages of the pharmaceuticals. Several veterinary randomized placebo-controlled clinical trials that have been conducted have


demonstrated objectively the benefit of cannabis for osteoarthritic pain, seizure, cancer, immune modulation, and more.


How it works

Every mammal has an endocannabinoid system (ECS). It is a complex cell-signaling system identified in the early 1990s by researchers exploring THC, a well-known cannabinoid. Cannabinoids are compounds found in cannabis that interact with receptors in our ECS. These receptors are found throughout your body. Endocannabinoids bind to them in order to signal that the ECS needs to take action. The endocannabinoid system is involved in a host of homeostatic and physiologic functions, including modulation of pain and inflammation.

What is Full Spectrum and Why is it Important?

A full-spectrum hemp extract is one where all the naturally occurring, bioactive compounds have been left in their natural state. While there are thousands of cannabinoids and terpenes present in each plant, and it is not possible to preserve every single one during the manufacturing process, full-spectrum means that none of the cannabinoids were purposefully removed. When these synergistic

compounds go through additional processing, the benefits of the plant are diminished and the incidence of side effects is increased. One of the biggest reasons full spectrum is so important is because the cannabinoids and terpenes all work together to enhance each other. This effect is called the Entourage Effect, and makes it possible for different cannabinoids to interact to achieve maximum effects ensuring maximum results.

What is a COA?

A CBD product's Certificate of Analysis, or COA, is a document with lab results showing you exactly what is in the product you are purchasing for your pet. This report will give you the specific quantity for each cannabinoid, including CBD and THC, that is in the product. This is how you can be sure that you are indeed buying a full-spectrum CBD product. The report will also show you what is NOT in your product, specifically toxins or heavy metals, so you know your CBD pet product is safe.

Arthritis & Joint Pain

CBD is super effective at reducing the pain and inflammation caused by arthritis and joint pain. This is one of the most researched subjects in the application of cannabis medicine for pets. CBD and other compounds found in a full spectrum hemp extract (such as THC, CBC, CBG, and THCV) are known to reduce inflammation throughout the body. In most cases of arthritis, the pain that our dogs feel is a direct result of inflammation in their joints. By soothing that inflammation, we can address the cause of the problem and also alleviate the hurt. A Baylor College of Medicine study found significant improvements in dogs with Osteoarthritis who received consistent doses of full spectrum hemp extract.

Conventional veterinarians often prescribe NSAIDs, which can lead to joint and soft tissue deterioration. They can also damage your dog's liver and kidneys. CBD is a safe anti-inflammatory alternative, without any of the negative side effects associated with

pharmaceuticals.

Seizur

CBD has been used by humans to manage seizures for years and has shown great success in both animals and people. In fact, in 2003 the U.S. government patented CBD as a neuroprotectant. A recent study assessed the short-term effect of CBD on seizure frequency in 16 dogs. Researchers found that 89 percent of dogs who received CBD in the clinical trial had a reduction in the frequency of seizures. Additionally, there was a significant association between the degree of seizure reduction and the amount of CBD concentration in the bloodstream. Antiepileptic medications, such as phenobarbital, are prescribed by most veterinarians to treat epilepsy and seizures. In addition to causing sedation, nausea, vomiting, and neurotoxicity in younger animals, one of the most significant side effects of phenobarbital is stress and damage to the liver.

Cancer

There are many ways that CBD may help with cancer. It's not only an effective way to fight the cancer itself, but it can help by improving quality of life. In addition to direct anticancerous properties, CBD and the other cannabinoids in a full spectrum hemp extract also have anti-nausea, pain managing and immunomodulatory effects.

In 2020, the first canine-specific CBD and cancer study was published. Researchers found CBD stopped cancer cells from spreading, as well as helping trigger apoptosis (natural cell death) and autophagy (the clearing out of damaged cell parts). According to research and my experience, a Full Spectrum Hemp extract will:

- Inhibit tumor growth (via apoptosis)
- Trigger death of cancer cells (via apoptosis)
- Inhibit the formation of blood vessels that feed tumors (angiogenesis)





















• Discourage the spread of cancer from one part of the body to another (metastasis)

Stress and Anxiety

CBD is a great option for anxiety, and has been used to manage anxiety and depression in humans. Clinical research shows CBD can contribute to the expulsion of aversive memories. Additionally, CBD can mimic serotonin by binding and activating the body's serotonin receptors. Often called the 'happy' chemical, these serotonin receptors are responsible for emotional balance.

A 2013 article published in Neuropharmacology found that CBD can help manage negative emotion surrounding triggers, like thunderstorms or fireworks, and helps manage PTSD and anxiety or panic disorders in people and animals. A 2019 study published in the Permanente Journal also found that CBD also has a calming effect on the central nervous system, and is better tolerated than other psychiatric medications.

Although some vets recommend giving your dog some children's Benadryl, it is important to remember that this drug is not intended for animals and can have side effects. For instance, Benadryl can put a strain on a dog's liver and kidneys, especially if they are already experiencing issues in those areas.

Cushing's Disease

Full spectrum Hemp Extract (CBD) can help dogs with Cushing's Disease by working with the body's endocannabinoid system to bring the body back to balance. This includes hormonal imbalances like the cortisol imbalance from the adrenal or pituitary glands. CBD can also reduce the growth of tumors, such as those that cause Cushing's, by inhibiting the formation of blood vessels that feed the tumor.

Veterinarians may prescribe hormone-regulating pharmaceuticals, and in some cases recommend surgery. However, surgery can be invasive and dangerous, especially in older dogs, and prescribed medications can cause additional side-effects.

Allergies

CBD is a great option for dogs with allergies, as it reduces inflammation, modulates the body's immune system, and also supports the gut, where 80% of the immune system resides. According to a recent study, CBD inhibits the release of the pro-inflammatory chemicals which end up causing the symptoms we know as allergies.


Conventional vets often prescribe Apoquel or Benadryl for dogs with allergies. These medications function by suppressing your pet's immune system in order to mute the symptoms of an allergic reaction. Unfortunately, the longer your pet is on an immunosuppressive drug, the higher the likelihood is that they will develop serious side effects and health conditions as a result. Instead of shutting off immune responses, as drugs like Benadryl and Apoquel do, CBD instead increases communication between cells in the immune system. This encourages a more moderate and targeted response to allergy symptoms.

Skin Conditions


For dogs suffering from skin conditions such as dermatitis, psoriasis, allergies, infections or even tumors, lumps and other unwanted growths, topical CBD is a great option. Scientists at the University of Pisa in Italy published an important study which documented an abundance of the two main cannabinoid receptors throughout the layers of dogs' skin. This allows for compounds like CBD to stimulate the skin's local endocannabinoid system pathways. CBD promotes healthy cell growth, inhibits vascular development to tumors, and inhibits growth of malignant cells. CBD salves can be great for topical relief of skin irritation from allergies, soothing inflammation and redness. CBD also helps moderate the immune response to allergens.

Although the benefits CBD can have for your pet are incredible, CBD for pets is still a largely unregulated industry. In a study done by Cornell University, researchers analyzed 29 'CBD for pets' products that were labeled "Full Spectrum," to determine if the claims on their labels were accurate. Only 10 of the 29 products were within 10% of the total cannabinoid concentrations of their label claim. Additionally, four of the CBD for pets products were contaminated with heavy metals. 



NIGHT

Organic unpasteurized goat's milk or cow kefir, follow feeding instructions; if you can find local source, use that.

Supplements:

- 42 mg of FSHE (full dropper) <u>CBD DOG Health's HEAL DOG</u> tincture after meal, apply directly to gums
- <u>Full Extract Cannabis Oil</u> with high THC (FECO or RSO), 10 mg, apply directly to gums (using different strains every month from Medical Cannabis/Marijuana Dispensary)

Meds and Food:

- Give supplements with food for better absorption; apply FSHE and FECO on gums.
- No chicken, beef, lamb. No wheat or grains No treats that aren't whole fresh foods.
- Feed and give treats within an 8-hour period, and fast after dinner for 16 hours.

Tips

- Chiropractic and Acupuncture are extremly beneficial and recommended.
- Filtered Water with added minerals or Hydrogen Water and quarter cup of Silver Hydrosol added to bowl




